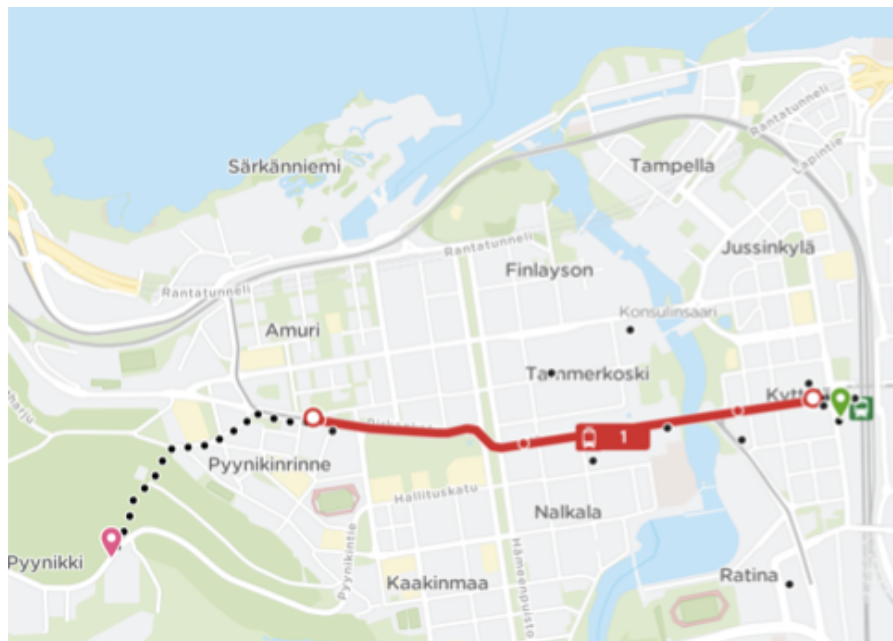

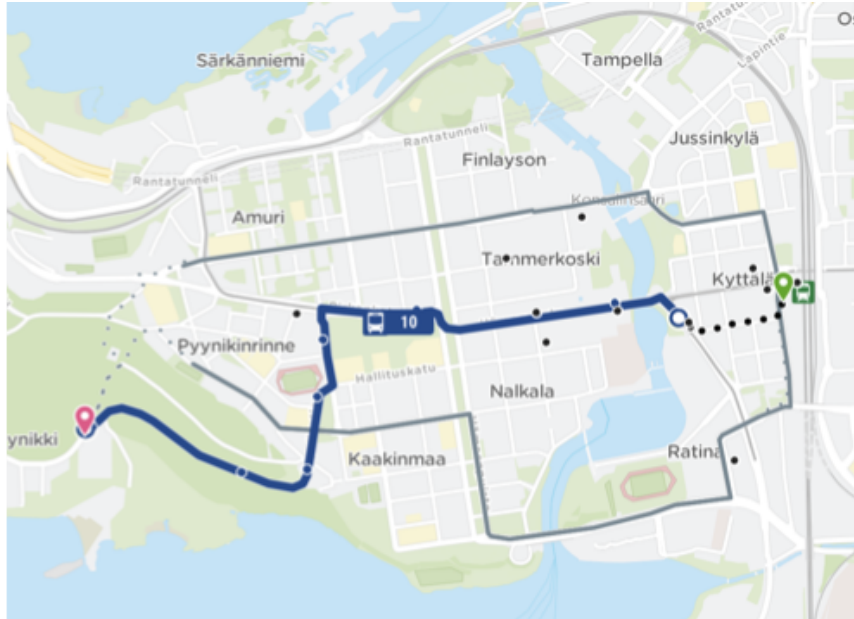
Transportation
